Thank you for your interest for the 2-day dovetail course.

During this course you will learn how to prepare timber for dovetails.

A series of marking out and cutting exercises will be undertaken before marking and cutting a set of through dovetails. An option of through dovetails with mitred corners and/or lap dovetails in preparation for box and drawer making can be undertaken.

You will use various marking out tools, chisels and saws and learn how to sharpen chisels.

Approx. Schedule

Day 1.

Arrive 9.a.m. Tea/coffee

Introduction and Health and Safety briefing.

Introduction to tools and marking out techniques.

10.45-11am Coffee and biscuits.

Marking and cutting techniques.

Lunch 12.45-1.30.

Marking and setting of joints, chisel sharpening, sawing and chiselling techniques whilst cutting dovetails.

A short tea break will be scheduled for the afternoon.

5pm summarise and close.

Day 2.

9am Start. The same break times will apply.

Review day 1 and continue on joints depending on progress and preference.

Cleaning up of joints.

5pm. Finish and summarise.

Lunch will consist of such things as soup, bread, cheese, pies, salad items etc.

If you have any allergies or dietary requirements it may be advisable to bring a packed lunch.

Please wear sensible clothing and stout footwear. PPE will be provided when necessary.

All tools are provided but if you have any of your own please feel free to bring them along.
